DAY 4 Munich - Regensburg

Depart Munich and journey by motorcoach to Regensburg, where your friendly Captain and crew welcome you onboard your luxurious Emerald Cruises Star-Ship. DAY 5 Regensburg

Begin the day with a leisurely walking tour as a local guide leads you through the cobblestone lanes of one of the best-preserved medieval cities. Discover the UNESCO World Heritage city center and see the city's architectural highlights. Enjoy a Bavarian sausage tasting during the tour for a real 'taste' of local life! Alternatively, join a bike tour to the Walhalla Monument, towering high above the slopes of the Danube. The site affords a fascinating view of the surrounding landscape and the river below. DAY 6 Passau

Cobblestone streets and graceful arcades welcome you in the beautiful city of Passau located at the confluence of the Danube, Inn and Ilz Rivers. On this morning's walking tour, stroll through the old town's narrow alleyways and see its noteworthy architecture. See St. Stephen's Cathedral, a wonderful example of Baroque architecture and home to Europe's largest pipe organ with more than 17,000 pipes. If you are feeling more active, join a bike tour along the River Inn. After a bit of free time, return to the ship for lunch and a leisurely afternoon sailing along the river. [Meals: B, L, D](#)

DAY 7 Dürnstein, Austria

This morning sail through the UNESCO World Heritage Wachau Valley enroute to the enchanting village of Dürnstein - "The Pearl of the Wachau Valley" - dominated by the magnificent Baroque Stiftskirche. Stroll through this tiny village on your own, or hike to the ruins of Dürnstein Castle where Richard the Lionheart was imprisoned. Alternatively, embark on a guided bike tour along the Danube, passing terraced vineyards, castles, and ruins along the way. This afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of Göttweig Abbey, one of Austria's

most important Benedictine abbeys. Sitting atop a hill near Krems, this architectural treasure overlooks the spectacular Wachau Valley.

DAY 8 Vienna

Welcome to Vienna, the capital of classical music and world-famous art exhibitions. Today you have a choice of activities: explore Austria's art history on an included tour featuring a visit to the Kunsthistorisches Museum, the largest art museum in the country and one of the most important museums in the world. Or, if you feel more active, explore on two wheels as you join the guided bike tour to Danube Island. Meals: B, L, D

DAY 9 Bratislava, Slovakia

Set on the crossroads of ancient trade routes in the heart of Europe, Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia, embodies various cultures – primarily Celtic, Roman and Slavic. Enjoy a guided walking tour through the lanes of the enchanting Old City with its Town Hall, Episcopal Summer Palace and the Slovak National Theater. Alternatively, embark on a guided hike to Bratislava Castle, offering beautiful views of the Danube. This afternoon, a highlight of the day will be a home-hosted visit where you are treated to tasty home-made specialties in the home of local Slovaks. What a unique opportunity to meet the locals and learn about life in Slovakia! This evening enjoy a gala dinner onboard. Meals: B, L, D

DAY 10 Budapest, Hungary

Budapest is Eastern Europe's liveliest and most cosmopolitan city. Enjoy a guided panoramic tour encompassing many of the city's hot spots. See Heroes' Square and travel along the Andrássy Avenue - a UNESCO World Heritage site, to see the historic architecture of this capital city. Alternatively, enjoy a hike to Gellert Hill. This evening, enjoy a local folklore show onboard, followed by a traditional Hungarian dinner. Meals: B, L, D

DAY 11 Budapest / USA

It's time to say farewell to the Captain and crew as you depart on the transfer to the airport for your flight home, taking with you wonderful memories of your cruise along the Danube River. Meal: B

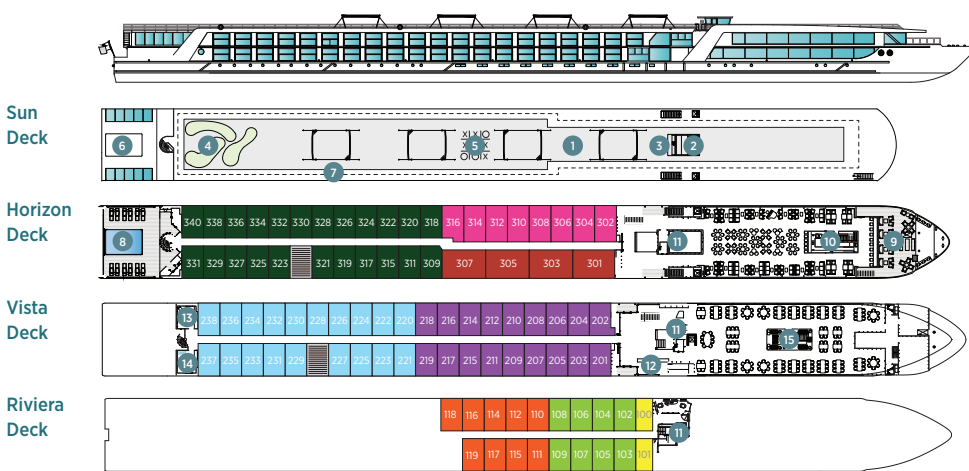

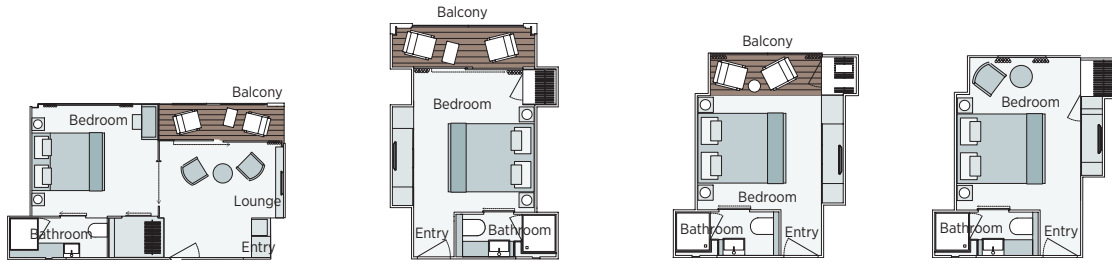
