

DAY 1 Your Adventure Begins: Excitement is high today as you leave the Midwest behind and motor into Ohio for the first night's stay. Later, gather with your Tour Manager and traveling companions for a welcome dinner. (Dinner)

DAY 2 Visit Washington, DC: Today, pass through the gentle rolling hills of southern Pennsylvania into Maryland, the "Old Line State," reportedly named by General George Washington. A local guide joins you for a tour of the mall area of the nation's capital to see the White House, Capitol Building, Washington Monument and more. Also, make a stop at the National WWII Memorial which was erected to honor all military veterans of the war, the citizens on the home front and the nation at large. (Breakfast)

DAY 3 Mariner's Museum and Virginia Beach: Begin the day at the Mariner's Museum and Park in Newport News. Designated as America's National Maritime Museum by Congress, it is one of the largest maritime museums in North America. Founded in 1930, the extensive collection of maritime artifacts is highlighted by the remains of the ironclad USS Monitor. Then, arrive in Virginia Beach, the state's largest city which boasts the world's longest boardwalk flanking miles of pristine sandy beaches. Enjoy a Virginia-style BBQ dinner



featuring slow roasted pork, hush puppies, local vegetables and plenty of local beers. (Breakfast and dinner)

DAY 4 Virginia's Tasty Eastern Shore: Because the Eastern Shore of Virginia is removed from the rest of the state, this narrow strip of land has a history and culture of its own. Begin with a memorable drive across the Chesapeake Bay Bridge for a visit to an aqua farm to see how Virginia clams are grown and harvested while on a VIP 'behind the scenes' tour. In the historic village of Cape Charles, enjoy a relaxing lunch of locally farmed seafood and homemade desserts while overlooking the bay. A stop at a local winery offers a tour and tasting highlighted by a variety of local cheese, charcuterie, seafood, and of course more wine while relaxing in beautiful vineyards.

(Breakfast and lunch)

DAY 5 Military Aviation Museum and Norfolk Naval Station:

Begin the day at the Military Aviation Museum, home to one of the world's largest private collection of vintage WWI and WWII military aircraft. Each have been beautifully restored to their original condition and many are still flown during flight demonstrations. After lunch, a stop is made at the Norfolk Naval Station. Here, take a 45-minute tour conducted by Naval personnel which gives you the opportunity to see the many aircraft carriers, destroyers, frigates and amphibious assault ships housed here. Be sure to have your photo ID handy. The General Douglas MacArthur Memorial tells the story of the man and also pays tribute to the many men and women who served with him. Dinner tonight is at Rockafellers featuring delicious local cuisine highlighted by lively musical entertainment. (Breakfast and dinner)

DAY 6 Depart for Pennsylvania: Leave Virginia Beach behind today and travel to the Pittsburgh area. Tonight, your Tour Manager hosts a farewell dinner with your traveling companions. (Breakfast and dinner)

DAY 5 New York City Tour and a Broadway Show: Today a local guide joins you to see New York City landmarks including Times Square, Chinatown and Rockefeller Center. 


DAY 4 Adirondack Park and Lake Placid: Travel through Adirondack Park for beautiful scenery on your way to the High Peaks region. There are breathtaking views of New York State's highest mountains in autumn color. A local guide takes you through Lake Placid, home of the 1932 and 1980 Winter Olympics. There will be time on your own here before arriving at your hotel, The Queensbury. (Breakfast and dinner)

DAY 5 Saratoga Springs and Lake George Lunch Cruise:

Heralded as the father of modern photography and motion picture film, George Eastman's home celebrates the art of photography, and its collection rivals that of the Getty Museum. Tour the home and enjoy lunch on own in the café before continuing on to Ohio and a farewell dinner hosted by your Tour Manager. (Breakfast and dinner)

Revision Fees

A fee of \$25 per person per transaction will be charged for any changes, revisions or alterations made to your reservation after confirmation.

Luggage Handling

The tour cost includes porterage for one average size suitcase. A charge of \$5.00 per hotel will be collected by the Tour Manager for each additional piece of luggage that you bring.

Travel Documents

Entry into Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean

A valid US passport is required for entry into Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean. No other documents will be accepted. Non US citizens must have a valid passport, visa or alien card which permits entry into these areas. In addition they will need a "multiple entry" visa for return to U.S.

Cancellation Fee Waiver (CFW) Motorcoach Tours

To protect you against cancellation fees should you have to cancel your tour or interrupt your tour en route, we have added an optional Cancellation Fee Waiver (CFW) in our deposit schedule. The CFW is non-refundable and non-transferable. The CFW cannot be transferred to another reservation, departure date or tour after booking has been made. Changing an existing booking to

another date or tour will result in losing the CFW premium paid on the original booking. If you do not wish to purchase the CFW, simply deposit the "without CFW" amount. This non-refundable fee waives all cancellation fees and penalties, provided we are notified of the cancellation one day before your tour departs. While on tour, if a passenger must leave early due to a personal illness, illness or death of a member of the immediate family or a traveling companion, the purchase of the Cancellation Fee Waiver guarantees full refund for any unused services. For motorcoach tours, return transportation will be provided (the mode of transportation will be determined at the discretion of Mayflower Cruises & Tours.)The injury or sickness must be, in the written opinion of a physician, so disabling as to cause a trip to be interrupted and must require the care and attendance by a physician at the place of occurrence.
